

2009 LEAGUE RULES

1. An organized league must have a minimum of 16 players (4 foursomes) to register. A non-refundable fee of \$50.00 per tee time will be assessed each league requesting a block starting time assignment. League fees must be paid by April 1st.
2. Afternoon league play can begin no earlier than 3:00 PM.
3. League play will be limited to Monday through Friday, excluding holidays. It is the responsibility of the league organizers to schedule their play around holidays.
4. Leagues will be given block starting time assignments when they are approved for play. Previous year leagues will have first choice of retaining their past starting time. Leagues will be limited to the same number of starting times as the previous year, unless there are times available.
5. Leagues will be scheduled to play front and back nines on alternate weeks. On the weeks that play is scheduled for the back nine, league players must be prepared to allow the infiltration of occasional 18 hole play.
6. Leagues requesting to keep their previous time slot must have their requests submitted to the Park and Recreation office, in writing, by February 1st, after that date time slots will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis.
7. All requests for league play should include starting and ending dates of play. This should include all league events. League block tee times will be in effect from the 1st Monday in April to the 1st Friday after Labor Day.
8. No scramble formats are allowed during normal league play. Requests for this type of format fall under the guidelines of special tournament rules and require a separate written request be submitted.
9. Leagues will be allowed to have only one time slot schedule. This time slot will remain in effect for the entire season. Leagues will not be allowed to change their times in mid season.
10. League officials must check-in with the starter 15 minutes before their time slot. At this time they should present their list of foursomes to the starter.

11. All league players are required to follow and comply with all posted golf course rules.
12. Leagues will be held accountable for the actions and behavior of their members.
13. All leagues are required to submit a schedule including beginning and ending dates and a roster of members to the Park and Recreation office before they begin play. No league will be allowed to begin play unless the roster has been filed.
