

2009 SPECIAL TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Weekend tournaments are not allowed until after Labor Day, with the exception of experimental Saturday afternoon dates that may be used between May 1st and August 31st. No holiday tournaments are allowed.
2. Weekday tournaments will be allowed Tuesday thru Friday, with a limit of one per week. If a weekend tournament is scheduled, only Tuesday and Wednesday will be available that week.
3. Shotgun tournaments must start at 8:00 AM
4. Special tournament fees will be charged at a flat rate for groups up to 144 players. This fee does not include carts.

Weekend Shotgun: \$3,500.00
Weekday Shotgun: \$2,500.00

Groups exceeding 144 players will be billed \$29.00 for each additional player.

Season tickets are not valid for special tournaments.

Carts are required for all tournaments with a minimum 36 required for shotgun tournaments at Western Hills GC.

Minimum Pro Shop charges (in addition to cart costs) for shotgun events are \$7.00 per player.

Minimum restaurant charges for shotgun events are:

Weekday: \$720.00 (WH) \$500.00 (EM)
Weekend: \$1,000.00 (both courses)

5. The tee will be closed to the general public until all tournament players have teed off. Tournament play will play uninterrupted through the back nine.
6. No outside carts may be brought in for any events other than approved tournaments.
7. **CART RENTALS ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR AND SHOULD BE RESERVED SEVERAL WEEKS IN ADVANCE.(THIS INCLUDES BLOCK TEE TIME TOURNAMENTS)** Contacts are listed below:

OUTSIDE CART RENTALS BY TOURNAMENTS ARE DONE AT THEIR OWN RISK. In the event that the course is deemed too wet for the use of carts, the tournament will have the option of playing the event without carts or rescheduling the tournament.

Under no circumstances are any carts to be allowed in the parking lots at any time.

8. Banquet facilities are available: For WHGC call 755-1331.
For EMGC call 754-0277.
It is strongly recommended that tournament organizers patronize the restaurant and Pro Shop facilities at the course where their tournament is scheduled.
9. Picnic groves are available for the fee of \$50.00 per event.
10. Keg beer with plastic cups may be obtained through the restaurants and set-up on the course as designated by the Superintendent of Golf Courses. Absolutely NO COOLERS will be allowed on either golf course.
11. All tournament requests should be submitted well in advance and are evaluated on a first come, first serve basis. No tournament requests will be accepted before January 1st of the upcoming season. All requests should be accompanied by a \$500.00 deposit.
12. Tournaments cannot be scheduled for both Saturday and Sunday at one course and tournaments cannot be scheduled for both courses on the same day. One day per weekend must be open to the public at each golf course. Weekday tournaments cannot be booked at both golf courses on the same day.
13. A non-refundable deposit of \$500.00 must be received by the Superintendent of Golf Courses at the time the tournament date is requested. This deposit will be applied towards the flat rate tournament fee. Tournament requests will not be accepted without the deposit and dates will not be approved until both the pro shop and restaurant facilities have received deposits for their services. The balance of all fees due to all parties must be paid in full 14 days prior to the tournament date. The tournament will be automatically cancelled if this deadline is not met.
14. Tournament organizers will be held accountable for their players complying with golf course rules.
15. All players must wear non-metallic alternative spikes. All golf shoes must be changed before a player goes on the course.
16. Special course set-up requirements should be submitted in writing 10 days in advance of the tournament. Due to insurance regulations, no course maintenance vehicles can be made available to tournaments.
17. Special tournament flags can be ordered for your event. A 4 month lead time is needed for delivery. Only golf flags with tubular swivels will be used.
