

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Waterbury, finds that prohibiting the hiring of an elected official as a city employee is in the best interests of city residents and will promote equality and fairness in selecting applicants for elected city positions and does, therefore, approve and adopt the following amendment to the City of Waterbury Code of Ordinances;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WATERBURY:

The following Waterbury Code of Ordinances § 39.50 entitled "Municipal Employment of Elected Officials", is hereby approved and adopted:

§ 39.50 MUNICIPAL EMPLOYMENT OF ELECTED OFFICIALS

No member of the City of Waterbury Board of Aldermen, City of Waterbury Board of Education, State of Connecticut elected assemblies, federal elected assemblies, or any other elected office of the City of Waterbury, State of Connecticut, or federal government shall seek or obtain employment with the City of Waterbury or its agencies during the term of said elected office and for one year thereafter.
