

MARRIAGE LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

- You must obtain a marriage license in the Connecticut Town where the marriage is taking place.
- Please choose your officiator and set the date of your wedding **before** applying for a marriage license. We ask that you provide us with the name of the person performing the ceremony and their telephone number.
- The Marriage Couple must both appear in person at the Vital Statistics Office. **The marriage license is valid for 65 days** from the date it is initially issued. Your wedding date must not be more than 65 days after you apply for the license.
- Bring with you **\$30 cash or money order**, your government issued **photo identification** and social security cards (if available).
- Each Party to the marriage must be at least 18 years of age to apply for the license independently. **If either party is between the ages of 16 and 17, a probate judge in the jurisdiction where the minor resides must approve of the marriage.** Children under the age of 16 are not allowed to marry per Connecticut State Law.
- If a person who wishes to marry has a Conservator, the Conservator must appear in person with a government issued photo identification, proof of Conservatorship, and a written statement of consent.
