

# PER CONNECTICUT STATE REGULATIONS

In order to apply for a Marriage License both parties must provide

## GOVERNMENT ISSUED PHOTO IDENTIFICATION \*\*

Which includes Date of Birth, Signature and Expiration Date

\*\* The Connecticut Driver's Only License, the Elm City Identification Card, and other government documents that are issued without sufficient proof of identity, will not be accepted. If the requester has this type of government issued identification, the source documents that were used to obtain the license or ID card must be presented so that the registrar can assess whether the documents meet Connecticut's requirements for obtaining birth certificates.

## TWO OF THE FOLLOWING\*

**NOTE:** Do not email copies of Social Security cards or any documents with visible Social Security numbers.

- Social Security Card
- Social Security Card supplemented with either an employment identification card, a paycheck stub or a W-2 form.
- Automobile Registration
- Copy of utility bill showing name and current address
- Checking account deposit slip or bank statement stating name and current address
- Voter Registration Card
- Valid government issued trade or professional license
- Valid government issued firearm permit
- Probation documents issued by a court or other government agency, pursuant to a criminal conviction
- Letter from a government agency verifying identity. The letter shall be dated within six months prior to the date of the request
- Release documentation from a correctional institution containing a photograph of the former inmate and a release date within 12 months prior to the date of the request
- Birth Certificate of the applicant
- Military discharge papers
- Current school or college photographic identification
- Government issued photographic identification that has expired within 12 months prior to the date of the request
- Other documents as approved by the State Registrar of Vital Records

\*Registrar has the authority to request any additional document from this list if authenticity of provided documents is questionable.
