EXAMPLES OF WORK (Illustrative Only)

Perform construction inspection for roadways, sidewalks and municipal construction projects; Assist with as-built drawing preparation as required; Attend project meetings; Keep detailed inspection notes, and reports; Coordinate construction activities including setting lines and grades; Make minor field engineering decisions; Act as City representative with members of the public; Verify contractor estimates and quantities; Perform field-testing of materials; Other related work as required or directed.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of principles and practices of civil and environmental construction; Knowledge of asphaltic, concrete, earthen and other construction materials; Ability to follow written and oral directions. Ability to read project plans and specifications; Ability to prepare detailed daily inspection reports by paper or tablets; Ability to perform basic mathematic computations for payment estimates and site layout; Familiarity with OSHA construction standards; Ability to understand, interpret and apply City and project standards and documents; Ability to communicate effectively with members of the public, contractors and other staff members Ability to use Microsoft Office computer programs.

REQUIRED EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

Minimum of four (4) years of construction experience in asphalt paving, earthwork, drainage or concrete construction. Recent degree or current enrollment in an engineering program (Civil, Environmental or Construction Management), NETTCEP Certification or Engineering or survey license desirable but not required and may be substituted for experience.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Possession of a valid Motor Vehicle Driver's License; Ability to stand and work outside for extended periods.
