As of February 24th 2022, at 4:00 PM, the total of laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 cases reported among Waterbury residents is 32,369 eight patients are currently hospitalized with laboratory-confirmed COVID-19. There have been 459 COVID-19-associated deaths.

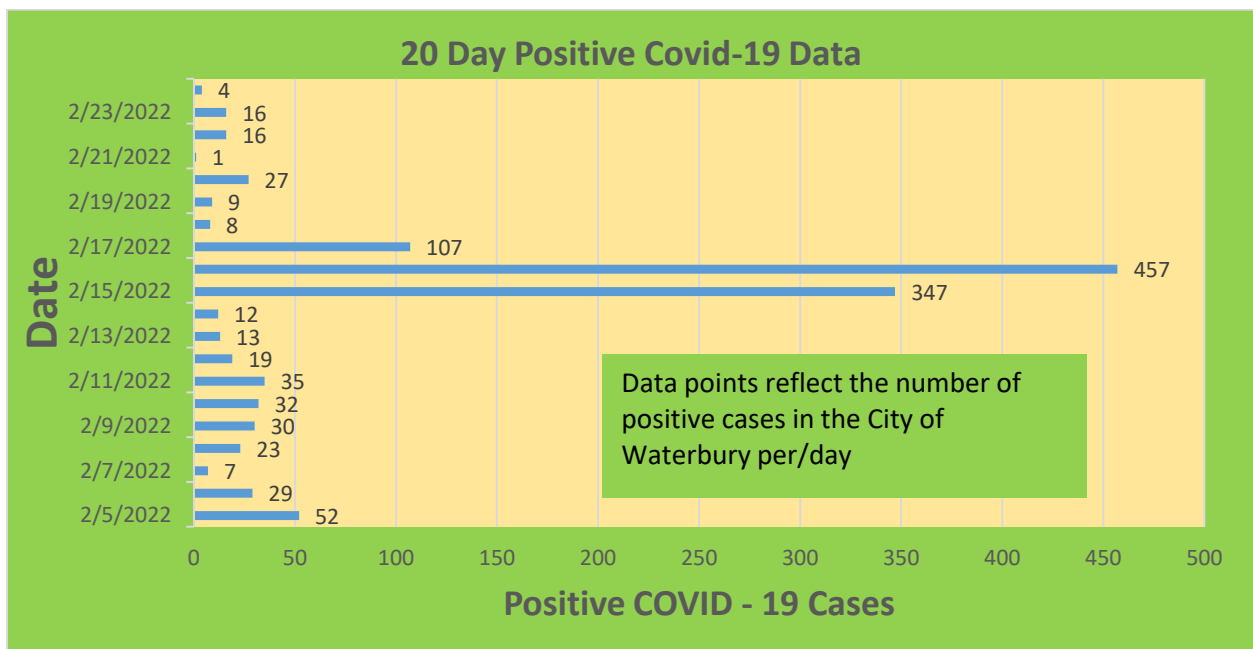
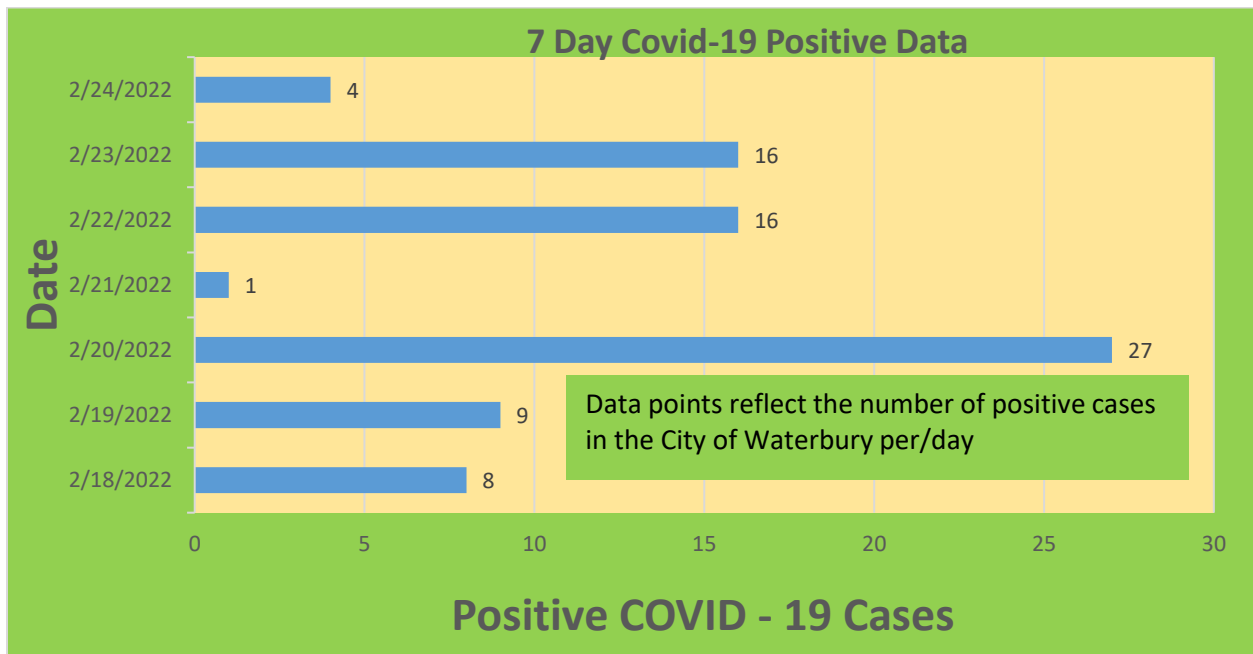

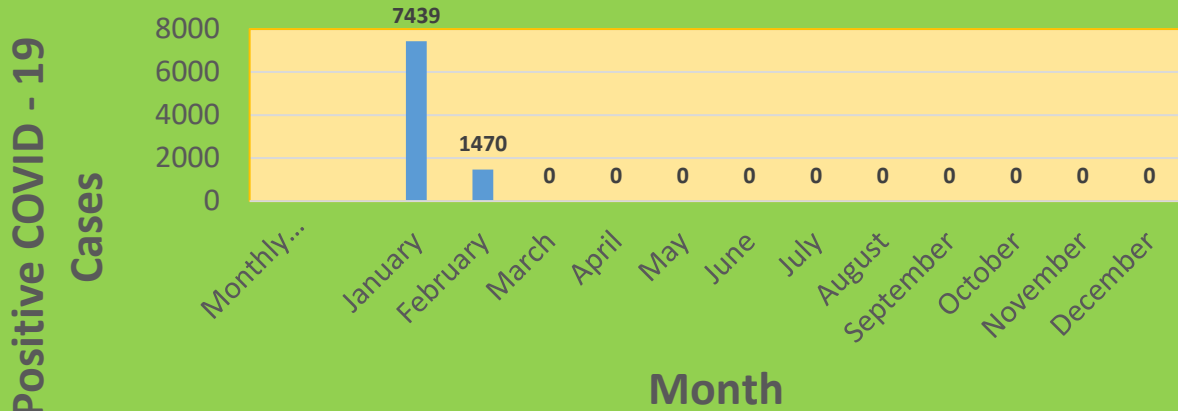

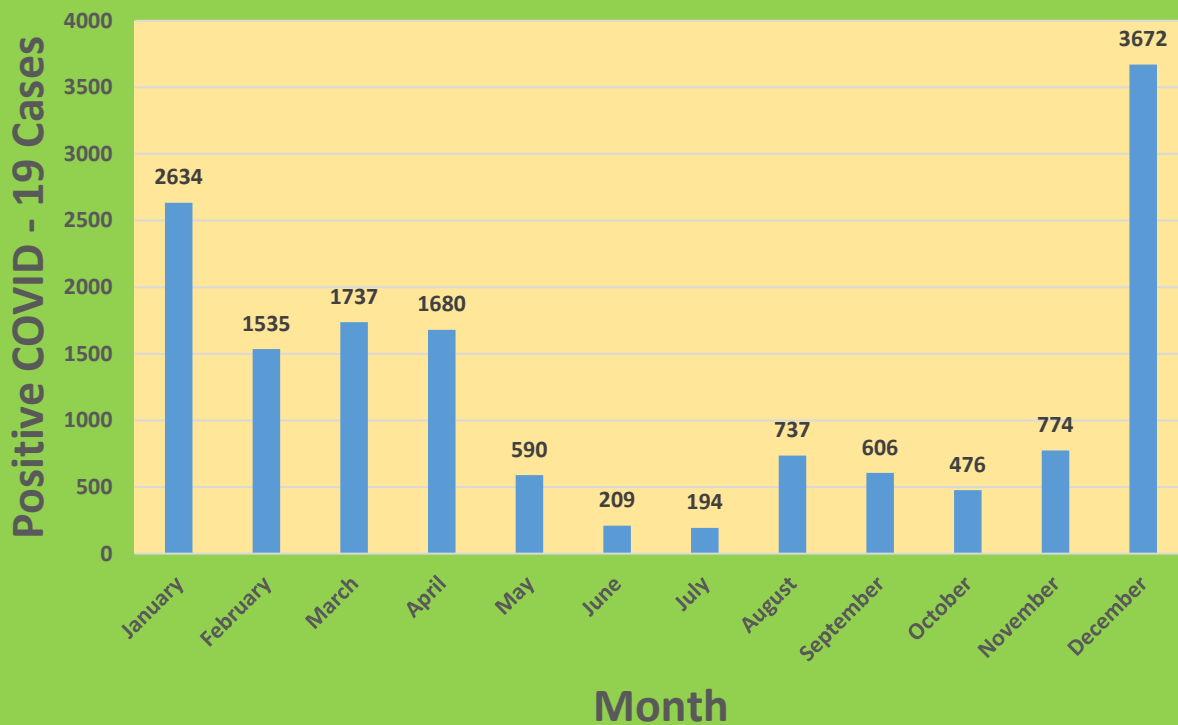

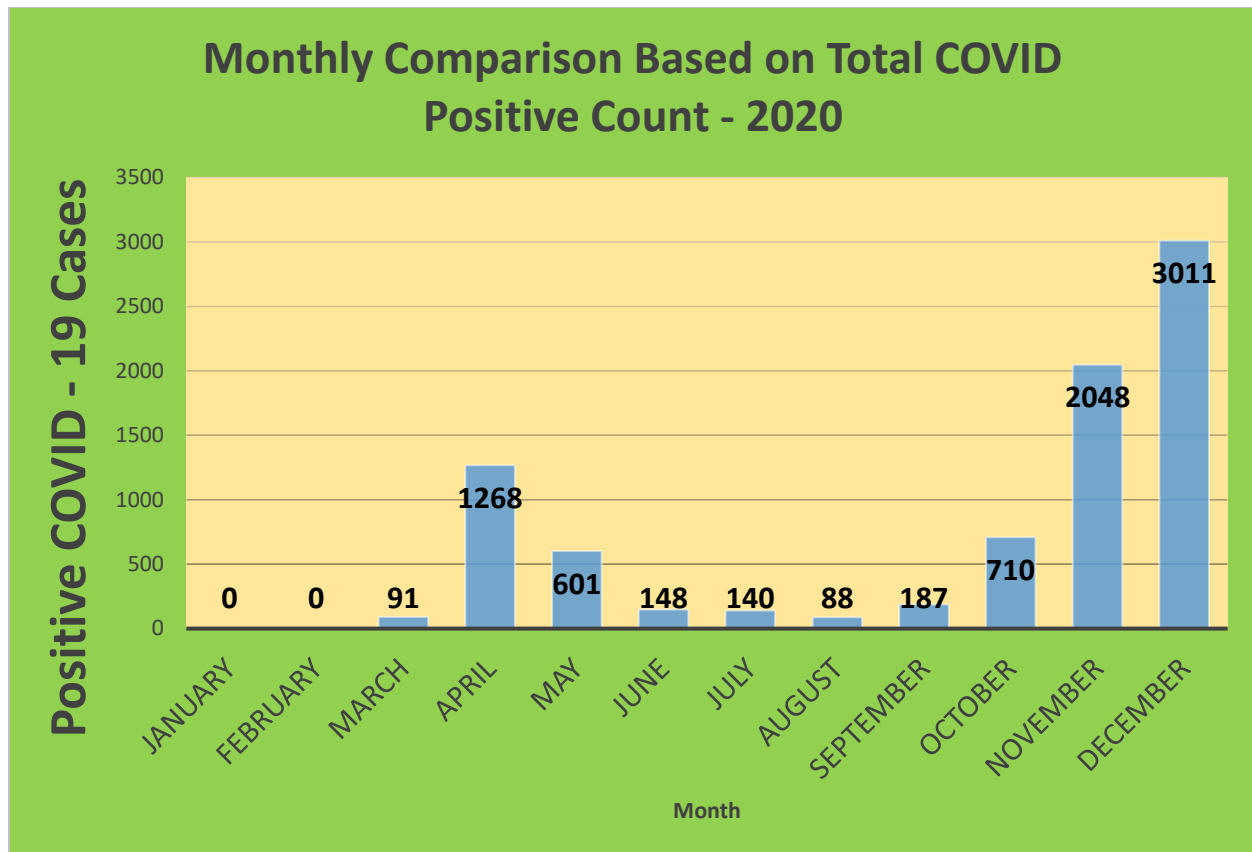


Monthly Comparison Based on Total COVID Positive Count - 2022
