

# Mayor Neil M. O'Leary City of Waterbury Daily Coronavirus Update February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022

As of February 24<sup>th</sup> 2022, at 4:00 PM, the total of laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 cases reported among Waterbury residents is 32,369 eight patients are currently hospitalized with laboratory-confirmed COVID-19. There have been 459 COVID-19-associated deaths.








### **Quick Resources:**
