

Notice about Absentee Ballots for the November 2020 General Election

The Secretary of State's Office has mailed every registered voter in Connecticut an application for absentee ballot. These applications are optional for voters who do not wish to vote at their polling location on Election Day.

Return completed applications to the Waterbury Town Clerk's Office by mail or by using the ballot drop boxes outside Waterbury City Hall. The ballot drop boxes are by the side entrance of Waterbury City Hall facing Silas Bronson library. There are also drop boxes at the Police Activity League (PAL) Recreation Center and the River Baldwin Recreation Center. You can place the application into any of these boxes.



The Town Clerk's Office will begin issuing ballots on October 2nd. Due to an expected high volume of applications, it is important that voters who wish to vote by absentee ballot submit their completed applications and ballots shortly after receiving them.
